Eligibility & Selection Criteria



HERITAGE-LISTED OR PERIOD BUILDING RESTORATION/ RENOVATION

- The Heritage-listed or Period Building Restoration/ Renovation category acknowledges excellence in the renovation/ restoration of a heritage-listed or period building which was constructed prior to 1970.
The renovation of a heritage or period building must incorporate the period features of the building by either restoring the original or matching the original period with new work.
- Projects may include modern fixtures and fittings.
- “Costs” must be based on the value paid by the client on completion
- Submissions must highlight any works not done by the builder
