## RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS



## Eligibility

The Residential category refers to projects that have been designed and built in consultation with owners or architects from a non-standard or heavily modified standard design

- All projects must be completed between
  31 August 2024 and 31 January 2026
- Must be a financial member of Master Builders Tasmania

## **Submission Requirements**

- Complete online nomination process on the <u>MBT Website</u>
- Upload a detailed PDF submission of your scope of works on the project that addresses the judging criteria. Please provide concise, relevant and technical information about the project;
- Upload any other information that will assist the judges in making their decision (ie additional letters of support)
- "Costs" must be based on the value paid by the client on completion
- Submissions must highlight any works not done by the builder
- Upload at least 4 x high resolution quality digital images (JPEG or TIFF format) at 300dpi\*

## **Judging Criteria**

Nominees will be assessed on the overall strength of their submission, including relevant evidence to support the following:

- Time performance
- Relationship with client and sub contractor management
- Degree of difficulty

#### INNOVATION

- Installation procedures

#### SITE MANAGEMENT

- Safety
- Site organisation
- Environmental management
