Eligibility & Selection Criteria

WORK HEALTH & SAFETY - RESIDENTIAL



The purpose of this award is to promote best practice WH&S on building and construction projects through the acknowledgement and celebration of excellence in health and safety. Entries in this category should include;

- Demonstrated commitment to implementing and achieving high standards of WHS management on a particular project
- An innovative approach to WHS issues which incorporates identification and assessment of workplace hazards and an appropriate solution to address the risks
- Implementing workplace safe systems which incorporate recognition of employee training needs, intent to adopt higher order control solutions and ongoing monitoring and review to achieve the desired outcome
- Any other details that support commitment to WHS excellence
- Photos documenting the WHS safety initiatives implemented onsite
- WHS management
- Explain any unusual circumstances and demonstrate how those issues were dealt with
- Explain lessons learned and application to future jobs (if any)
- Training/ communication with stakeholders to ensure that the intended WHS outcomes were achieved
- Workplace hazards
- Provide details on the company's actions in identifying, assessing and controlling these particular workplace hazards
- Employee involvement
- Demonstrate employee involvement by providing details of the employees and Sub Contractors who participated in the process, especially where they played a part in identifying or forming a solution to deal with the risk
- Safe work systems
- Provide details on the company's safe work systems for the project which incorporates recognition of any specific training needs, processes, systems or control solutions and where possible any ongoing monitoring and reviews
- Any performance statistics that provide supporting evidence of the success of the project
